### Summary Description

<b>Purpose/Need</b>
The purpose is to install a buried power utility line on Forest Service Road 186B to provide power to electric service customers.
<b>Intended Selected Action</b>
A trench will be dug adjacent to Forest Service Rd 186B with the purposes of laying 3,450 feet of electric power line. No merchantable timber will be removed.
<b>Potentially Significant Effects or Extraordinary Circumstances (if any)</b>
No significant effects or extraordinary circumstances are expected
<b>Public Involvement (include State, local governments and Tribal consultation)</b>
Project was scoped to all parties interested in special use projects on the district as well as county officials and tribal agencies on November 26, 2019. No comments were received.

The decision will be made pending archeological concurrence from the Mississippi archeological heritage. The decision is not subject to objections.
