DISKETTE PROGRAMS

The diskette contains three programs. Of the three programs, McFinder will be the most useful to transportation engineers and is discussed below. **Please be advised this program only works in a DOS environment (not Windows).** To use the diskette, type "readme" at the diskette drive prompt for the program instructions.

McFinder

This program provides information about products, services, and ordering. The entire package is menu driven and may be run directly from the floppy diskette by typing "MCFINDER".

The program categories for McFinder are:

- Highway Engineering
- Traffic Engineering
- Transit
- Transportation Planning
- General Interest
(i.e. shareware and miscellaneous software)

The other two programs available on the diskette are **McFile**, a file management program, and **McSaver**, a screen saver.
