AS2M is designed specifically for resource specialists who manage aircraft to safely conduct missions including aerial sketch mapping, photo/remote sensing, wildlife and vegetation surveys, and aerial reconnaissance in general.

Course Objective: Combined with on-line prerequisites, AS2M provides all necessary coursework to qualify students as “Fixed-Wing Flight Manager – Special Use”.

Course Subjects:

Address three broad topic areas 1) Aviation Safety and Management, 2) Conducting a Mission, 3) Aviation Administration and Policy.

IAT-approved courses including: A-205/305 Risk Management I & II, A-302 Personal Responsibility and Liability, A-303 Human Factors in Aviation, A-307 Aviation Policy and Regulations, and Crew Resource Management 7 Skills N9059 (RTN9059 refresher included and equivalency for A-310 CRM is available).

FHP-specific curriculum including: Accident and Incident Review, Flight Plans/Following and Dispatch Operations, Selecting the Right Aircraft, Aircraft Instrumentation, Meteorology and Flying Weather, Mountain and Canyon Flying, Airspace Coordination and Safety Management Systems.

Course Schedule:

April 2nd–4th, 8:00–5:00 daily with the possibility of an early start and late finish on the second or third day. All courses will be held at the Rachel Carson State Office Building, Room 105. Print and bring student workbooks downloadable from the IAT registration page and please bring your laptop.

Transportation:

Least expensive flight options include flying into Philadelphia or Baltimore International Airports, the Crowne Plaza Hotel is approximately two hours away. Valet parking is available at the hotel for a discounted rate of \$15/day, self-parking is available within walking distance to the hotel.
