UPCOMING EVENTS

October 17-20, 2016. Bend, OR. The 8th Western Hazard Tree Workshop. The three day workshop will have a day and a half indoors featuring legal issues, how hazard tree evaluation procedures are changing (including the use of drones), documenting evidence, case studies, and a workshop on identifying tree decays. The field trips will include hazard tree failures at Mt. Bachelor Ski Resort, tree autopsies, drone demonstrations, hazard tree management post fire, compare rating systems for hazard trees, and Douglas-fir dwarf mistletoe pruning. The meeting will include a social on Monday evening, October 17th, a photo contest and poster session, and an evening banquet at the Deschutes Brewery Mountain Room.
