

2323 - MANAGEMENT OF OTHER RESOURCES IN WILDERNESS

2323.04 - Responsibilities.

2323.04e - District Ranger. The District Ranger is responsible for approving the following uses on sites within Wilderness which have been approved through the NEPA process:

1. Temporary storage of commercial fishing gear.
2. Temporary shore ties and waterlines.
3. Temporary tent platform facilities for the taking of fish and wildlife.
4. Temporary facilities for fisheries research, management, enhancement or rehabilitation.
