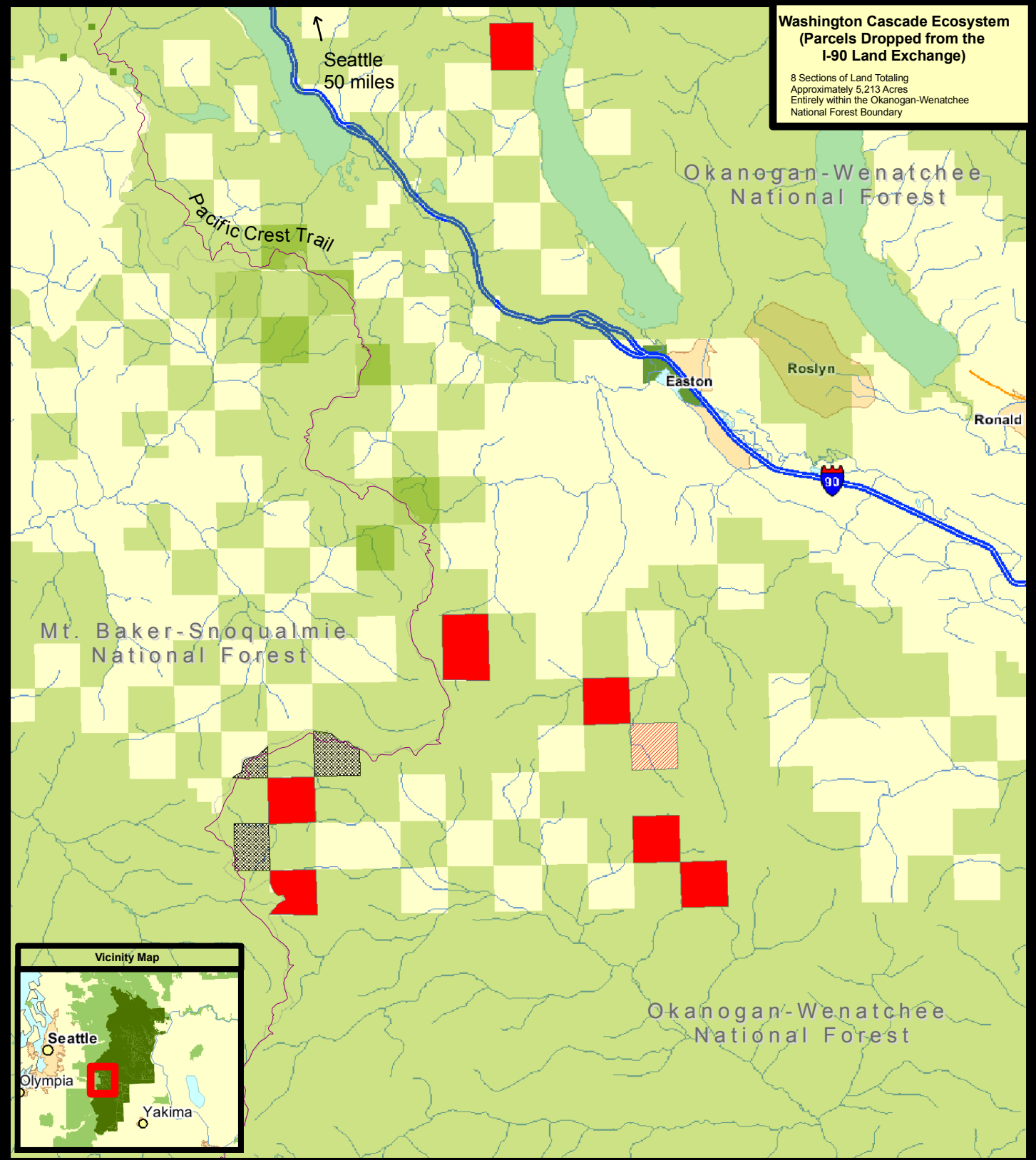


**Washington Cascade Ecosystem

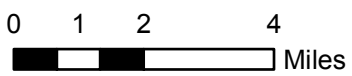
