¹ Definitions of units:

National forests.—Areas established as national forests by Act of Congress or Presidential proclamation. Acreages shown as under Forest Service administration do not include land utilization project lands over which the Forest Service has supervision by order of the Secretary of Agriculture; such lands being listed under the classification "Land Utilization Areas."

Purchase units.—Areas established by the Secretary of Agriculture with the concurrence of the National Forest Reservation Commission but not formalized by Act of Congress or Presidential proclamation. Acreages shown under Forest Service administration do not include land utilization project lands over which the Forest Service has administration by order of the Secretary of Agriculture; such lands being listed under the classification "Land Utilization Areas."

Experimental areas.—Areas outside of the exterior boundaries of national forests or purchase units which have been reserved and dedicated to forest or range research and experimentation by Executive order or other authorized administrative action.

Land utilization areas.—Lands acquired by the United States in pursuance of certain national programs of land utilization and adjustment, which by order of the Secretary of Agriculture have been placed under the administration of the Forest Service but have not yet been given a national-forest status. Some of such lands are wholly or partially within the boundaries of national forests or purchase units, but their acreage is not shown as part of the national forest or purchase unit acreage. The figures for this classification are based upon the following definitions:

Gross area: That part of the project not included within the boundaries of a national forest, purchase unit or experimental area.

Area not under Forest Service administration: The private, county, or state lands within that part of the project that is outside of the boundaries of a national forest, purchase unit, or experimental area, less the acreage under Forest Service administration within such units listed on page 13.

Area under Forest Service administration: All lands within the project boundaries which have been acquired by the United States and placed under Forest Service administration, regardless of whether they are inside or outside of national forest, purchase unit, or experimental area boundaries.

² Acreages of small administrative sites outside of proclaimed boundaries and the three small shop sites in Montana, California, and Wisconsin are included.

³ Acreages of small administrative sites outside of established boundaries are included. Does not include lands within certain state forests in Michigan which have been acquired by the United States with intent to exchange them for State lands within the National forests. The Massabesic Experimental Forest in Maine and the McNeill Division of the Harrison Experimental Forest in Mississippi, which have both purchase-unit and experimental-forest status are only included in the experimental area summaries.

⁴ Exclusive of 1,890 acres of the Beltsville Research Center of the Department of Agriculture, assigned to the Forest Service for use as an experimental area. The Massabesic Experimental Forest in Maine and the McNeill Division of the Harrison Experimental Forest in Mississippi, which have both purchase-unit and experimental-forest status are only included in the experimental area summaries.

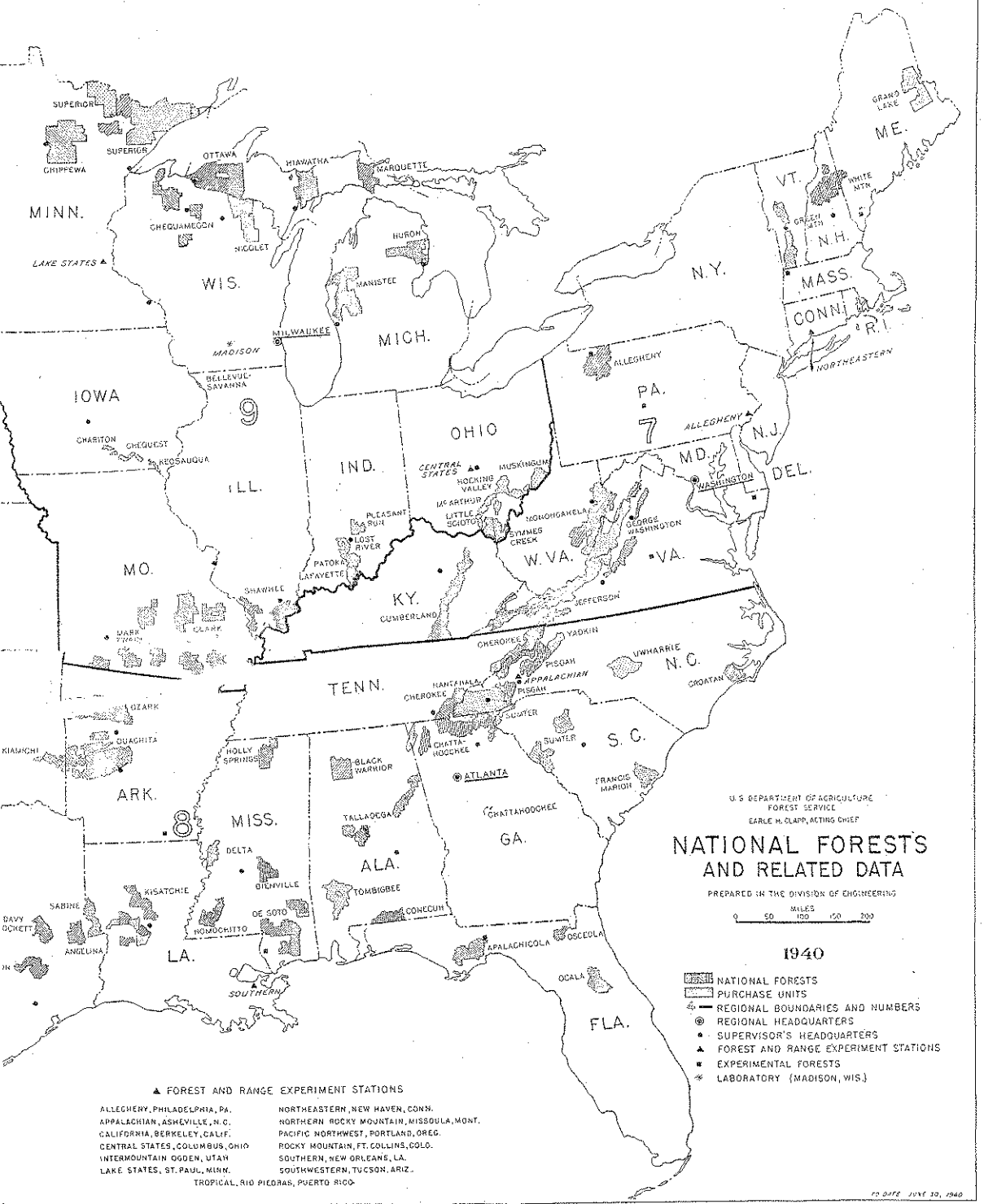
