


WATER, FISH, AND YOU

QUICK FACTS




Clean, healthy waters are a natural draw for people; ***promoting human health and well-being.***



Fishing, a ***gateway outdoor recreation activity***, introduces many Americans to the outdoors and their public lands.



The Forest Service oversees incredible habitat for public consumption on ***220,000 miles*** of fishable streams and rivers and over ***10 million acres*** of fishable lakes and reservoirs.



Recreational fishing on the National Forests and Grasslands supports more than ***\$2.2 billion of economic activity*** each year nationwide.



The Forest Service has some of the highest quality waters and aquatic habitat in America; including both ***80 percent*** of freshwater mussels and clams and ***60 percent*** of the fish listed under the Endangered Species Act.



The Forest Service delivers drinking water for ***20 percent*** of all Americans.
