

Forest Land Cover Change (1975-2000) in the Greater Border Lakes Region:

Time series examples from differently managed areas of the Border Lakes ecoregion

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Map Description

The large upper right panel displays land cover and large natural disturbances (i.e., fire and blowdown) for the Border Lakes Region circa 2000. Inset panels display closer views of land cover through time (1975-2000) for three representative regions 1) managed forest in Ontario, 2) managed forest in Minnesota, and 3) unmanaged forest in the wilderness area. These land cover classification datasets (Wolter et al. 2012) were produced to facilitate analysis of forest disturbance patterns, to support landscape simulation modeling, and to support cross-ownership land management within the region.





