

Fire Engine Identifier Standards

Numbering



Striping

- ▣ 1" - 3" - 1" White reflective striping.
- ▣ Meets NFPA Standards
- ▣ Lower 1/3 of engine body
- ▣ Follows body design



Rear Marking

- ▣ Alternating red and white DOT striping on rear bumper

Driver and Passenger Doors

- ▣ BLM FIRE - 3.5"
- ▣ BLM emblem
 - 12"
- ▣ State and District identifier - 3.5"
ex. NV-CCD



Side

- ▣ Engine Number
 - Black 6 inch Block
Bold reflective upper
rear package (both
sides)



Front



Engine Number – 5" Both sides of bumper

Rear

Engine Number - 5" Upper left of package



Top

- ▣ Engine Number - 18" top of cab as read from rear.

Driver and Passenger Doors

- ▣ BLM FIRE - 3.5"
- ▣ BLM emblem
 - 10"
- ▣ State and District identifier - 3.5"
ex. NV-CCD



Side

- ▣ Engine Number - 5" upper rear package (both sides)



Front



Engine Number - 5" Both sides of bumper

Rear

- ▣ Engine Number - 3.5"
Upper left of package



Top

- ▣ Engine Number - 18" top of cab as read from rear.



Blended Units

- ❑ Special consideration will need to be allowed for multi-agency equipment.
- ❑ These units will follow the BLM standard
- ❑ May add Multi-Agency logo to one or both sides
