


Converting a PDF to Mobile Format Using XP

Before beginning you must have the PDF reader installed on your Laptop/PC and Allegro MX. See instructions for installation in **“Installing Adobe Reader Pocket PC on Laptop_Allegro MX.docx”**

1. For Windows XP users, establish an **Active Sync Connection** (will not work using Windows Mobile Device Center, found on machines running Windows Vista, 7, or 8) with your PDR. Look for this Icon in the lower right corner of your monitor  right click on the icon and select **Explore**.


2. Click on **My Windows Based Mobile Device**  , and then navigate to the folder that you want to save the PDF file into. It is recommended to use the SD card provided with your Allergo MX




If you have subfolders navigate to the destination folder and open the folder, leave this window open.

3. Navigate to the PDF that you want to convert and either drag and drop the pdf, or copy and paste the PDF into the open folder on the PDR from step 2 above.


Adobe will add **“Tags”** to the converted document making to easier to view on the mobile device. Click **OK** when you see the following box.



You will see the following box as Adobe is scanning and tagging the document.



Once the tagging is done Adobe will Copy & Convert the document.



Once everything is finished you will notice that in most cases the new (converted) document is significantly larger in size than the original.
