


Passwords in MIDAS

The MIDAS system requires two passwords for every MIDAS user. One password is to access the MIDAS web site and one is to run the MIDAS program on the PDR.

Before new field crew personnel can use MIDAS they must be entered into the main MIDAS database, given the next available Crew Number, and be set up with the default passwords. For all new MIDAS users the default web site password is **up2you** and the default PDR password is **pdrpassword**. The first time a new MIDAS user logs into the web site, the system requires them to change both passwords to something unique. The web site password cannot be **up2you**, the PDR password cannot be **pdrpassword** and the two passwords must be different. When a new MIDAS user logs into the web site for the first time (by choosing their name from drop-down box and using their default **up2you** password), they will see this:
