Proposed Regulation Updates: Locatable Minerals

A webinar will be presented by Forest Service staff to:

- Provide an overview of the proposed revisions to the Locatable Minerals regulations at 36 CFR 228 Subpart A,
- Discuss how to submit comments, and
- Discuss how to engage in Tribal consultation.

The USDA, Forest Service is proposing to revise its Locatable Minerals regulations at 36 CFR 228 Subpart A. These regulations govern operations under the mining laws that occur on National Forest System lands in order to minimize, to the extent practicable, adverse impacts to surface resources. The existing regulations have been in place since 1974. The revisions are intended to provide for better protection of surface resources, and to improve the efficiency of Forest Service regulation of those mining operations. The revisions will also increase the consistency with Bureau of Land Management surface management regulations for similar operations at 43 CFR 3809.
