Proposed Directives Updates: Timber Management

A webinar will be presented by Forest Service staff to:

- Provide an overview of the proposed updates to Timber Management Directives;
- Discuss how to submit comments;
- Discuss how to engage in Tribal consultation.

The USDA Forest Service is proposing several updates to its Timber Management Directives. The proposed changes include updates to FS Manual 2470 and FS Handbook 2409.17 for Silvicultural Practices as well as updates to FS Handbook chapters 2409.11a on Cubic Scaling on Stacked Wood and Piles, 2409.12 on Timber Cruising, and 2409.18 on Timber Sale Preparation. The amendments are part of a broader effort to improve efficiency in how the agency manages forests, delivers forest products, and carries out timber sales, in part through updating Directives to reflect new authorities and more closely align with current and future forest restoration needs.
