



## Tribal Information Webinar

### **Proposed Directives Updates: Wilderness Management**

Forest Service staff will present a webinar to:

- Provide an overview of the proposed updates to the agency's Wilderness Management Directives;
- Discuss how to submit comments; and
- Discuss how to engage in Tribal consultation.

The USDA, Forest Service is proposing a limited set of narrow revisions to its Wilderness Management Directives to clarify activities allowed in Congressionally designated wilderness areas under existing laws and in the interest of public safety and forest health. Forest Service Manual 2320 contains direction for those portions of the National Forest System designated by Congress as units in the National Wilderness Preservation System. The existing directives have not undergone a significant revision since the 1980s. The proposed revisions would increase the consistency of line officer decision-making in managing wilderness areas and improve consistency between USDA's wilderness policy and that of the Department of the Interior.
