2007 Accomplishments

Partnerships:

- Challenge Cost Share Agreement with Wildland Restoration Volunteers to collect seed, remove weeds and restore parts of the 2003 Overland Wildfire burned area near Jamestown, Colorado.

Seed Collections:

- Collected seeds of five grass species and one wildflower species to be stored over the winter and planted directly into one of three sites chosen for restoration in the Overland Burn.

Preparation for seed increase:

- Reconnaissance of the Overland Burn to plan for weeding and seeding projects in 2008 and 2009 by the Wildland Restoration Volunteers.
