FY2008 Native Plant Material Accomplishments

Using FY2008 NFWV funds we accomplished the following:

Production costs for extracting and testing seed collected on contract in FY2007 (\$2,431).

Prepared a contract for propagation of hardwood trees and shrubs from seed collected in FY2007 (\$7,000). (*Bids were received but funds were lost to fire transfer before the contract was awarded.*).

Administered on-going contracts for seed collection and plant propagation continuing from FY 2007.

Designed and installed trial plots of a “desirable non-native” seed mix intended for use on decommissioned roads in watersheds where local native seed is not yet available.

Program development: integration of native plant materials program with forest wildlife, aquatics, and engineering programs.

Force account field collections of *Danthonia spicata*, *Rupertia physodes*, *Parnassia palustris*, and *Spiraea splendens* for seed increase at NRCS Corvallis in FY2009.

Using NFN3 funds we accomplished the following:

Field preparation and sowing of grass seed increase fields of *Elymus glaucus* and *Bromus carinatus* at JH Stone Nursery (\$8219).

Using funds obligated in previous years:

Completed propagation contract for 1000 containerized plants for revegetation of a decommissioned campground and an associated wetland damaged by OHV/ATV use. Plants will be installed in early November 2008
