



Native Plant-Pollinator Gardens on the Allegheny National Forest

2013 Accomplishments

Program activities in FY2013 included maintenance and enhancement of existing Native Plant Pollinator Gardens by seasonal and full time staff. A new garden was created (Figure 1) by removing a bed of hostas at the Northern Research Lab in Irvine PA and replacing one plant species with over 20 different plant species. This garden was created by the Bradford Youth Conservation Corps (YCC) (Figure 2). The YCC crew also installed a bird bath and new plants at the SO garden in 2013 (Figures 3 and 4).
